



### ABOUT THE FUND:

The NTWWA is offering a Scholarship Fund for the first time. There are two streams under which you can apply:

#### **1. Training Grant Award - \$1,500**

Designed to encourage both mid-career individuals or youth planning to begin or continue their education training in the water and waste water treatment field.

#### **2. Campaign Grant Award - \$1,500**

Designed to encourage Community Groups (like: Cadets, Guides, Youth Groups, School Classes, etc.) to run community educational and/or environmental campaign on a water and/or waste topic.

### HOW TO APPLY:

#### **To apply you MUST be:**

- a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant.
- a resident of Nunavut or NWT.

#### **STEP 1. Fill out an Application Form.**

Submissions will be accepted in either short answer format (250 words or less per question) **OR** through a video response.

#### **STEP 2: Provide a Letter of Reference**

Can be from an employer, a teacher, a community leader, etc.

#### **STEP 3: Provide Proof of Registration or a Campaign/Learning Plan.**

### SCHOLARSHIP PAYMENT:

Winners will be notified by the NTWWA Scholarship committee by **February 28, 2018**. The scholarship monies will be issued in two equal installments.

#### **Training Grant Award:**

The first installment will be issued upon receipt of 'Proof of Registration'. The second installment will be issued upon Proof of Completion of the course/training.

#### **Campaign Grant Award:**

The first installment will be issued prior the start of the Campaign. The second installment will be issued upon completion of the campaign.
